# McMurray Masters Talladega

As Johnson Pads Point Lead With Unlikely Top-10 Finish

TALLADEGA, Ala. - Jamie McMurray's victory in Sunday's wild NASCAR Sprint Cup AMP Energy 500 at Talladega

Superspeedway couldn't have come at a more opportune time for the driver who is **SPRINT CUP** about to be out of a ride at Roush Fenway Racing at the end of this season.

The victory snapped an 86-race winless streak for McMurray. But it was Jimmie Johnson who left Talladega Superspeedway with the most to celebrate after finishing sixth while his closest championship pursuers Mark Martin and Jeff Gordon were both involved in a massive 13-car crash heading toward the white flag.

Because of that, NASCAR can make plans on engraving Johnson's name on his fourth-straight Sprint Cup champi-

On a day when it looked like Johnson's sizeable point lead would dramatically shrink, Johnson gained by not racing.

Johnson drove from the mid-30s to a sixth-place finish as his two leading contenders for the title, Martin and Gordon, were swallowed up in a huge crash on the frontstretch that ended the

## Izod Puts Mark On IndyCar As Series Sponsor

Title Package Worth \$10M Annually

ATLANTA - After 10 years without a series sponsor, the IndyCar Series

will unveil Izod as the title sponsor beginning with the 2010 season.

The clothing company just concluded its first season as an IndyCar partner and was pleased with the success it had with IndyCar and the Macy's department store chain.

Izod's series sponsorship is expected to be worth \$10 million annually.

The last time IndyCar had a series sponsor was 2001 when Northern Light — an Internet search engine finished the second year of what was supposed to be a longterm contract with the Indy Racing League.

This is a great move for IndyCar because Izod is a company that can market its product to all age groups and is a consumer-based entity that can help bring IndyCar back into the mainstream.

And because IndyCar Series racing has always been as much about lifestyle as the extreme form of racing, perhaps Izod can help make this brand of racing more fashionable

Motorsports Park may have been the last NASCAR event at the three-quar-

ter-mile asphalt oval. Dover Motorsports, Inc., owner of the facility, has announced that it is ceasing operation of the track and that it will promote no races there 2010. Previously scheduled NASCAR Nationwide Series and NACAR Camping World Truck

Series events at the track will be moved to other Dover Motorsports facilities. Dover Motorsports had previously entered into an agreement to sell the

track to Gulf Coast Entertainment,

but the sale fell through when Gulf

Coast could not secure funding to

make the purchase.

"This was a difficult decision for us, but one that ultimately was dictated by economics," said Denis McGlynn, president and CEO of Dover Motorsports. "We greatly appreciate the many years of dedication shown by our Memphis employees and their efforts to make Memphis such a great destination for the racing community from racing fans and drivers to sponsors, team owners and sanctioning bodies.

"For all concerned, including the Memphis community, it is truly sad to see Memphis Motorsports Park taken off the racing schedule. NASCAR has approved the realignment of our NASCAR Camping World Truck Series and NASCAR Nationwide Series events from Memphis Motorsports Park to our Nashville and


Gateway facilities."

The NASCAR Camping World Truck Series event scheduled for Memphis will be held April 2 at Nashville Superspeedway in conjunction with a previously scheduled Nationwide Series race.

The Nationwide Series event will move to Gateway Int'l Raceway and will be held Oct. 23.

The move also means the end of the NHRA drag race at the adjacent drag strip. NHRA officials announced that the Full Throttle Drag Racing Series schedule will be reduced to 23 events with the elimination of the race in Memphis.

Brad Keselowski won the Oct. 24 Nationwide Series event at the track and an ASA race scheduled for Saturday will still be held at the track.
